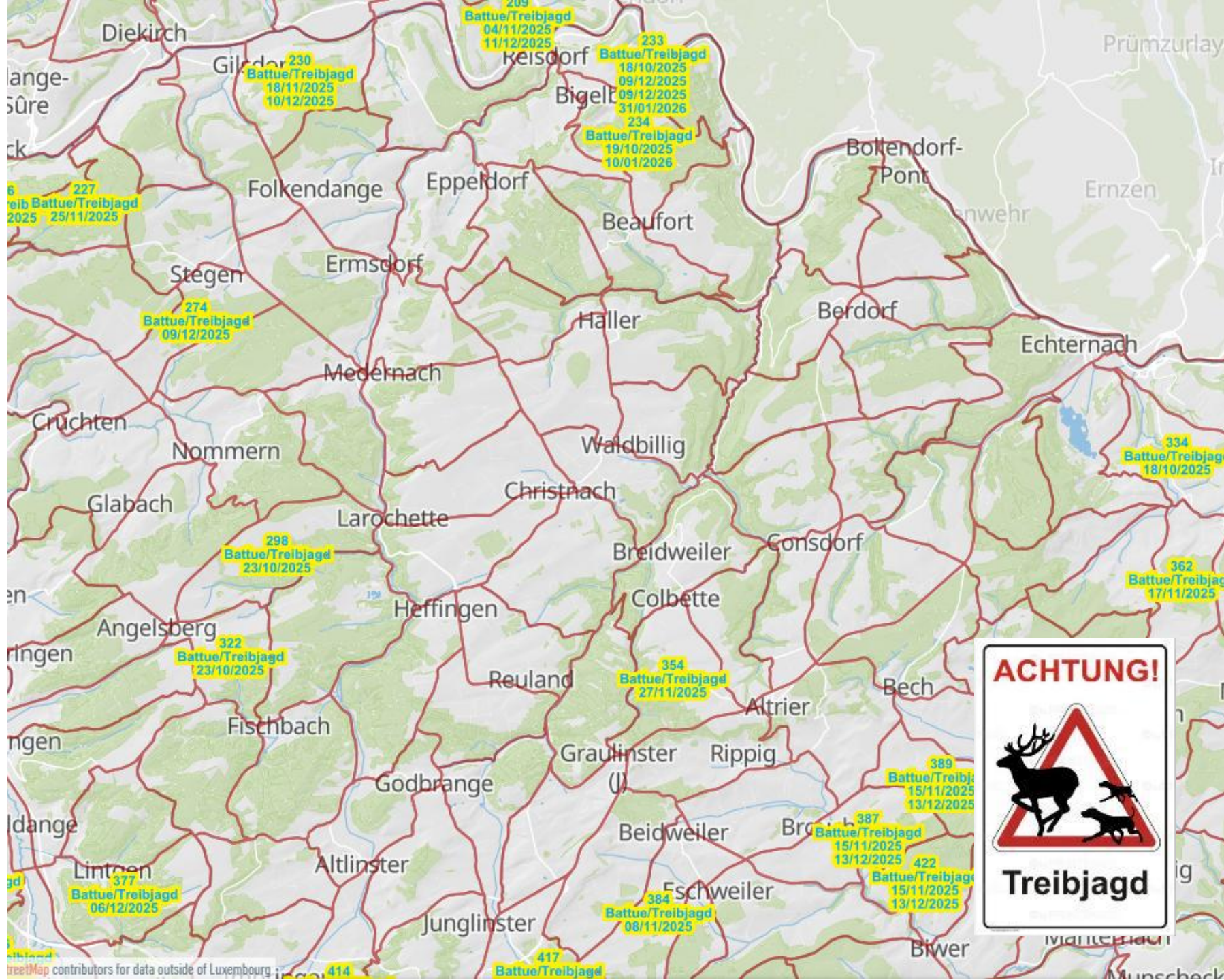


Hunting season!

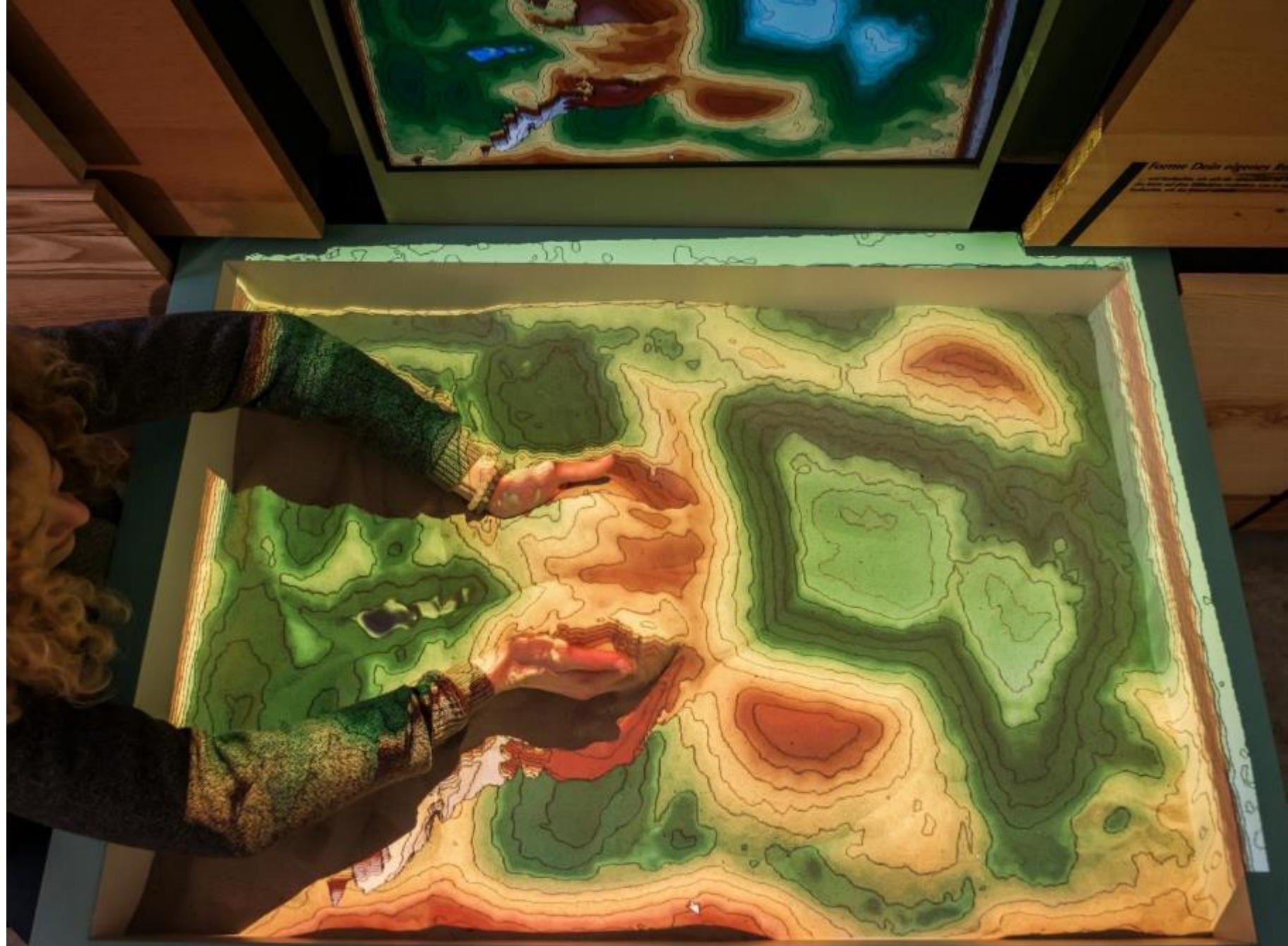
