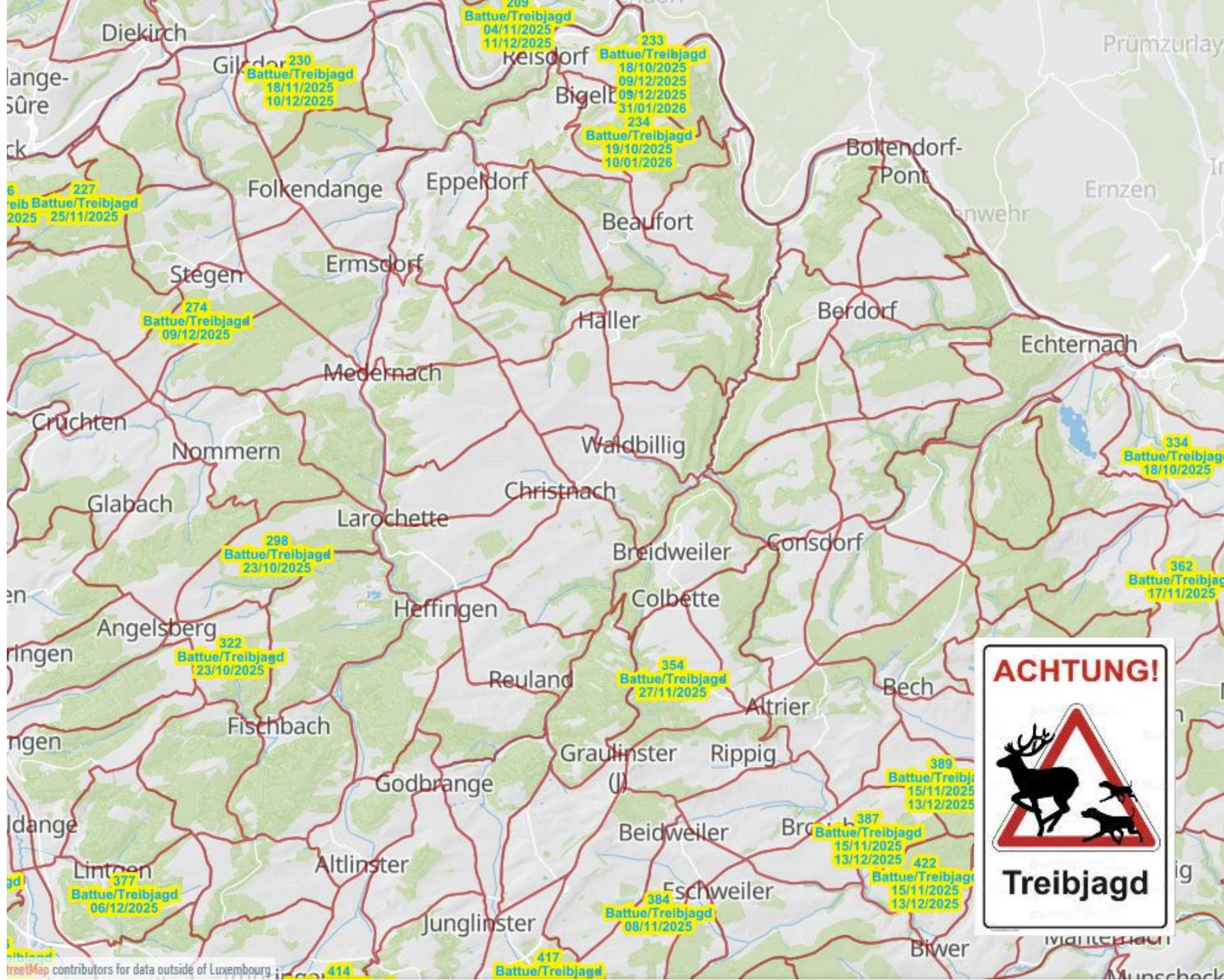


Hunting season!

Geo-Pad Haupeschbaach & Halerbaach

The nature trail leads for about 5 km through the valleys of the Haupeschbaach and the Halerbaach. It is marked with a fossil oyster ("devil's claw") which reminds us that our rocks were formed in a sea long time ago.
