**La lumière fascine le monde
Licht fasziniert die Welt**

Avant son ouverture déjà, l'Exposition internationale d'électricité de 1900 à Paris poussait les regards, ici les gens découvrent, étonnés, chose qui n'a considérément comme impossible : de la lumière, de la lumière électrique pour chaque usc, appliquée aux yeux, représentée, animée par des milliers de lampes à incandescence. Ces lampes se déplacent gracieusement de leur émission de lumières à grise et se passent de la force des lampes à gaz. La consommation en énergie. Ensuite, il y a tout à coup comme pour la main d'un fantôme, les immenses lampes se contentent de une sur de lumière électrique pour éclairer de la clarté du jour. L'Américain Edison présente machine géante, la générale "Jumbo", capable de produire du courant pour 1200 lampes à incandescence. Le Russe Jochoboff expose une lampe à arc analytique. L'Allemand Siemens présente un tramway qui avance sans chevaux de tract, mais grâce à une force motrice purement électrique !

L'exposition connaît un succès retentissant. Les journaux annoncent un déclasse simple d'espia, modeste, continu et à portée de Mousset tout le monde. La nouvelle parvient jusqu'à dans les endroits les plus reculés, et avec elle, la fascination pour l'électricité.

Schon im Vorfeld erregt sie große Aufmerksamkeit: die „Internationale Elektricitätsausstellung“ 1900 in Paris. Hier erleben die Menschen etwas, was sie nicht für möglich gehalten haben: Licht, elektrisches Licht für jeden Raum, zugemessen aus Tausenden von Glühlampen erzeugt, ohne den bliebenden Geruch des Gaslichts und eine sauerstoffverzweifelte Flamme des Petroleum. Ein elektrisches Lichtheim, plötzlich wie von Geisterhand gleichzeitig in zahllosen Glühlampen entzündet, macht die Nacht zum Tag. Der Amerikaner Edison stellt eine riesige Maschine vor, der Generator „Jumbo“, der Strom für 1200 Glühlampen erzeugt kann, der Russe Jochoboff zeigt eine verheissende Brugelglühlampe, der Deutsche Siemens präsentiert eine Tramway ohne Zugpferd, allein durch Elektrizität angetrieben!

Der Erfolg der Ausstellung ist gewaltig. Die Presse vom einfachen, geschicklichen, wundervollen Licht für jedermann geht von der Tagesspresse in jede Wirklichkeit und wird für die Faszination der Elektrizität.
