**Die Unternehmen wie die landwirtschaftliche Genossenschaft Prathba Yasudha und die Textilfabrik Prathba Syntex im indischen Bundesstaat Gujarat versuchen, mit Unterstützung der NGO Fairtrade einen anderen Weg zu gehen. Im Fairtrade-System wird den Unternehmen und Kooperativen unter anderem zusätzlich zum Verkaufspreis eine Fairtrade-Prämie ausbezahlt, die bis zu 10% des Verkaufspreises beträgt. Ein demokratisch gewählter Ausschuss entscheidet, in welche sozialen, ökologischen oder ökonomischen Projekte investiert wird. Das Geld dient demnach der Finanzierung von Gemeinschaftsprojekten, z. B. zur Verbesserung des Zugangs zu Bildung, der Gesundheitsversorgung, dem Zugang zu sauberem Wasser und sanitären Einrichtungen.**

**Some companies, like the Prathba Yasudha agricultural cooperative and the Prathba Syntex textile factory in the Indian state of Gujarat, are trying to take a different path with the support of the NGO Fairtrade. In the Fairtrade system, the companies and cooperatives receive, among other benefits, a Fairtrade premium amounting to up to 10% of the sales price. A democratically elected committee decides which social, ecological or economic projects to invest in. The money is used to finance community projects, e.g. to improve health care, sanitation, access to education and access to clean water.**

**Radheshyam has been growing cotton for 31 years. He owns three hectares on which he grows organic Fairtrade cotton for the Prathba Yasudha cooperative. His two children will soon attend the school whose construction was financed with the fairtrade premium:**

**“I hope that they get a good education so that they can be something in the future. We have not made any decisions for them yet. It depends on what they want to become.”**

**„Hins weniger Leckereien erhalten werden und die Kinder eine bessere Ausbildung erhalten können ist ein großer Schritt für die Eltern. Wir denken, dass unsere Kinder gut lernen und in der Zukunft Erfolg haben sollten.“**

**After her marriage, Suman became a smallholder with the Prathba-Yasudha cooperative. She also works as a weaveress. Thanks to the school financed by the fairtrade premium, her children are getting a good education.**

**“If there are less sweets and children get a better education, they can grow and their parents feel good in future.”**


