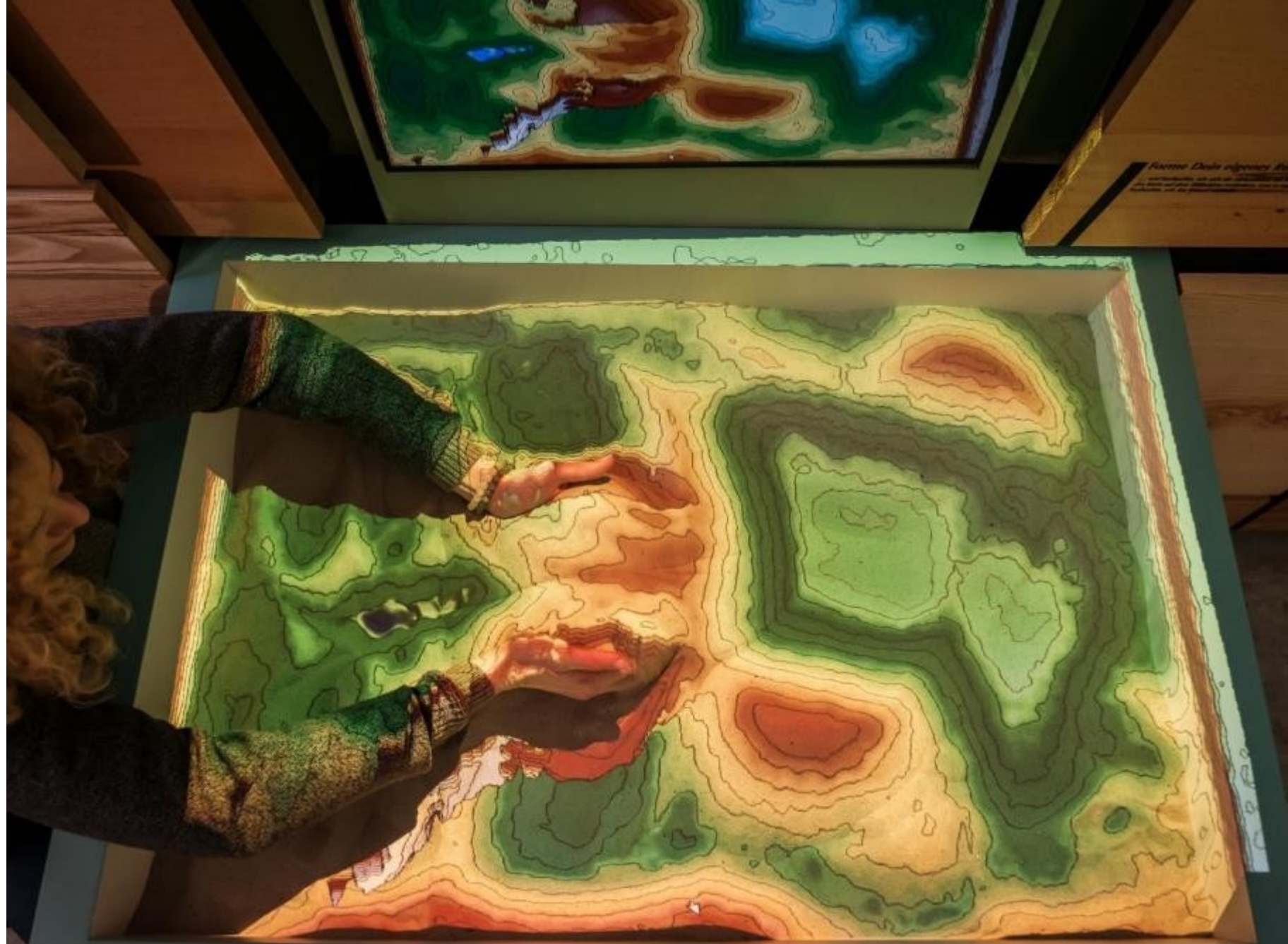
Geo-Expo Natur- & Geopark Möllerdall
