🚧 Local hiking trail L4 and Auto-Pédestre Larochette (mid-August to end of September)

✗ German part of NaturWanderPark delux Felsenweg 1, 3 & 4 and Auto-Pédestre Bollendorf and local hiking trail B17 (possible to use public transport for return)

✗ Auto-Pédestre Grundhof (until autumn 2026)
